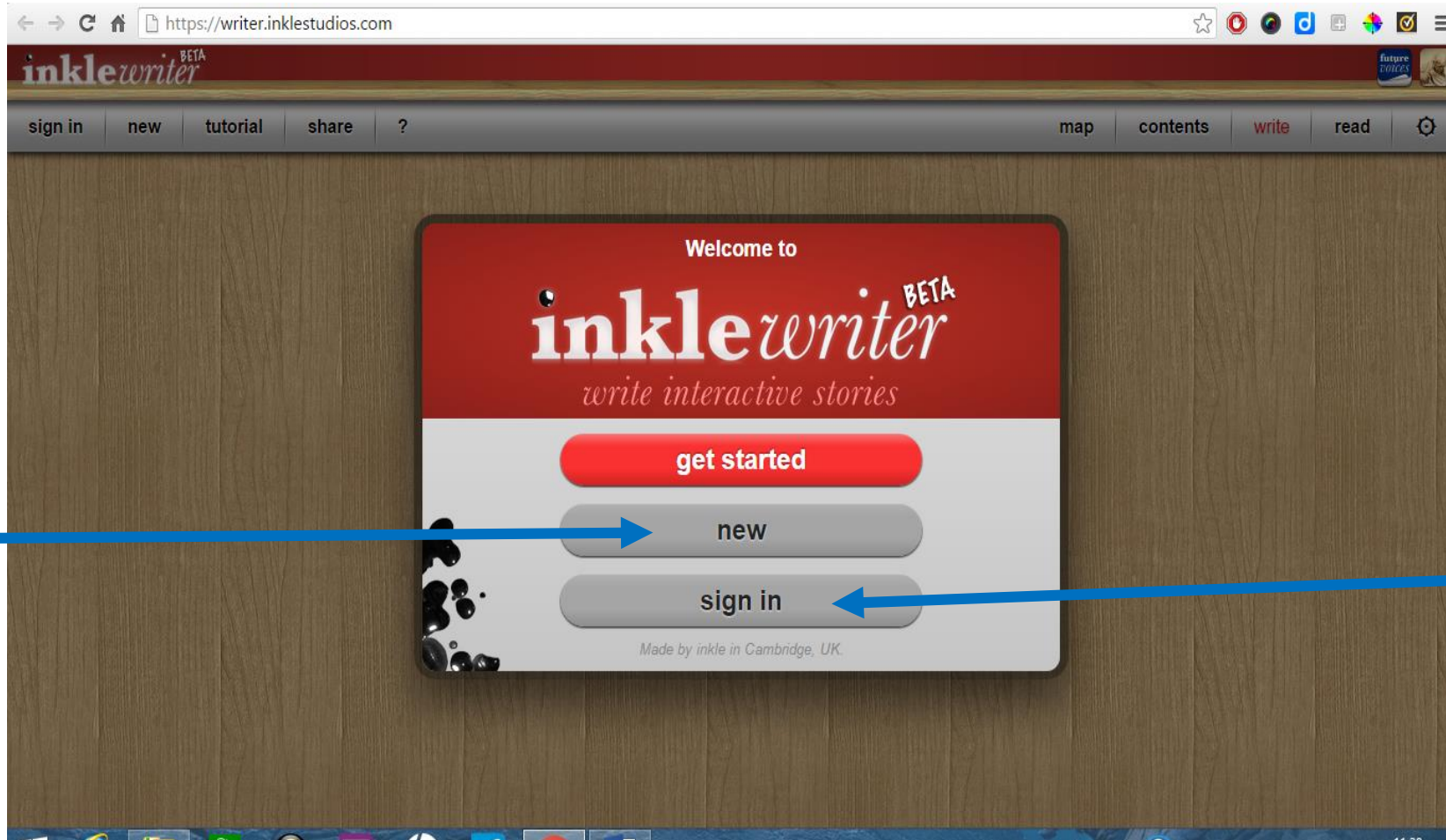


## Create an interactive story with Inklewriter

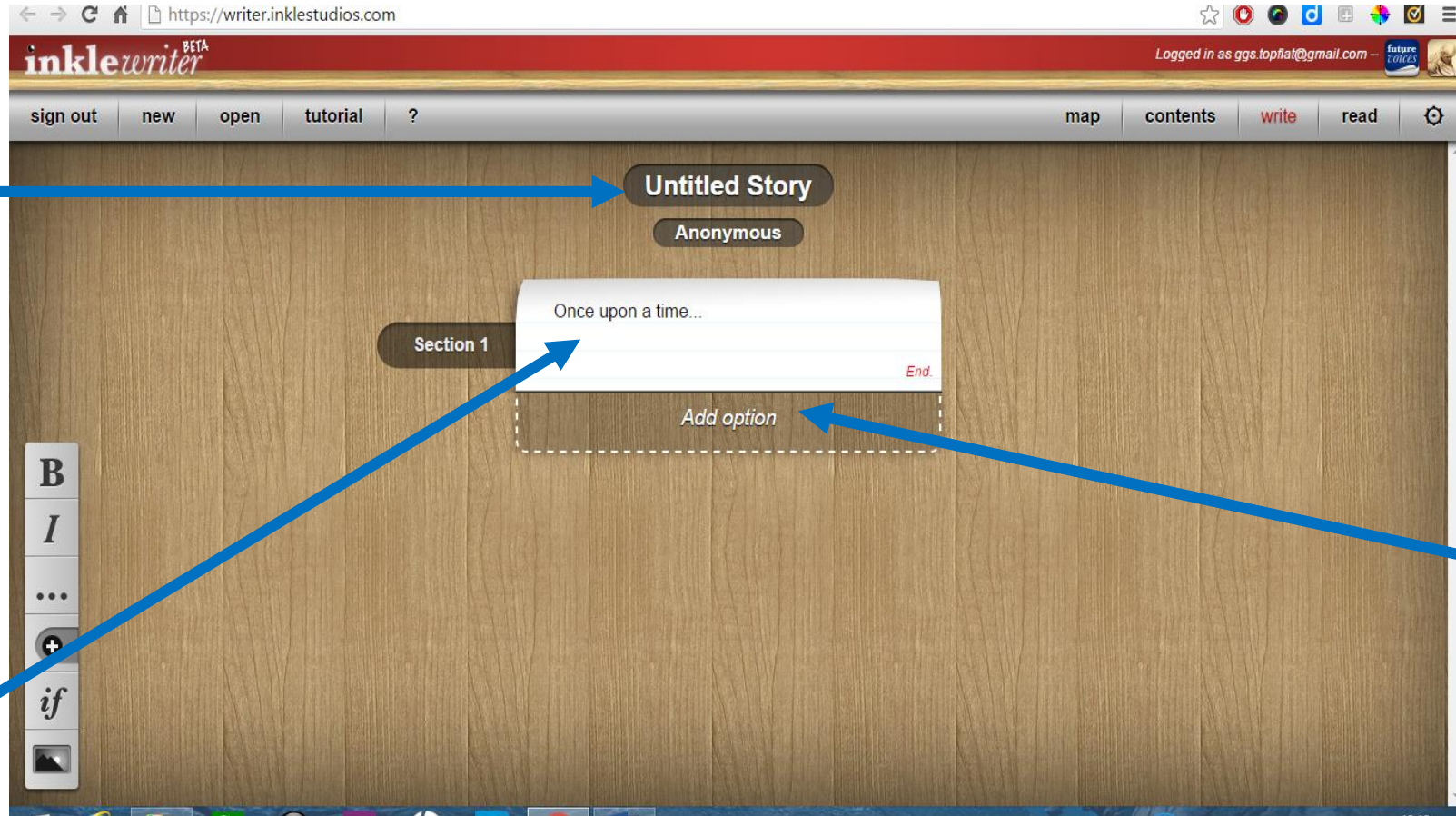

Click here

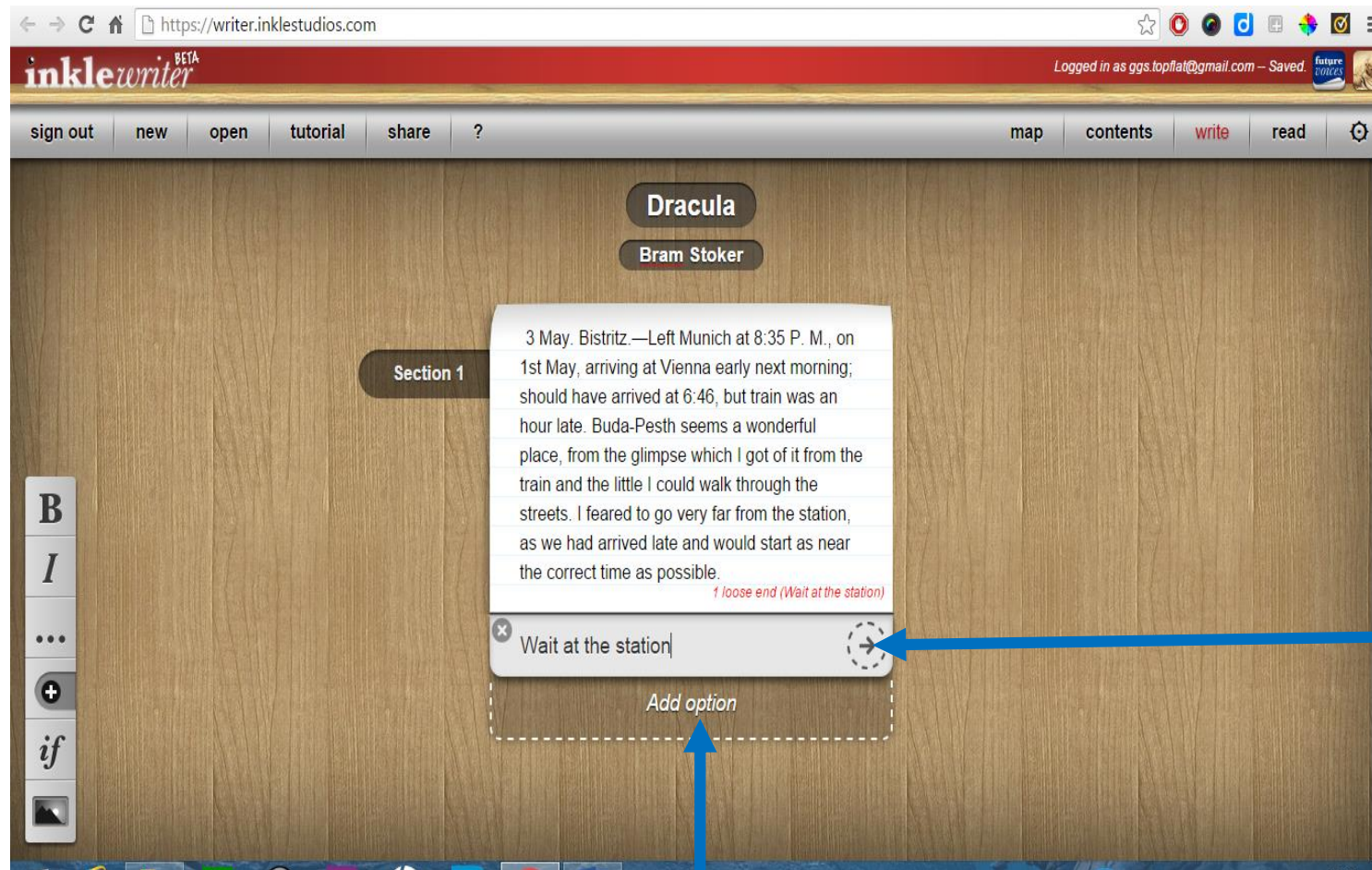
If you click here you can create an account, save stories and then edit them from any computer with internet access.

Click here and change the story title



Click here and type in the first part of your story

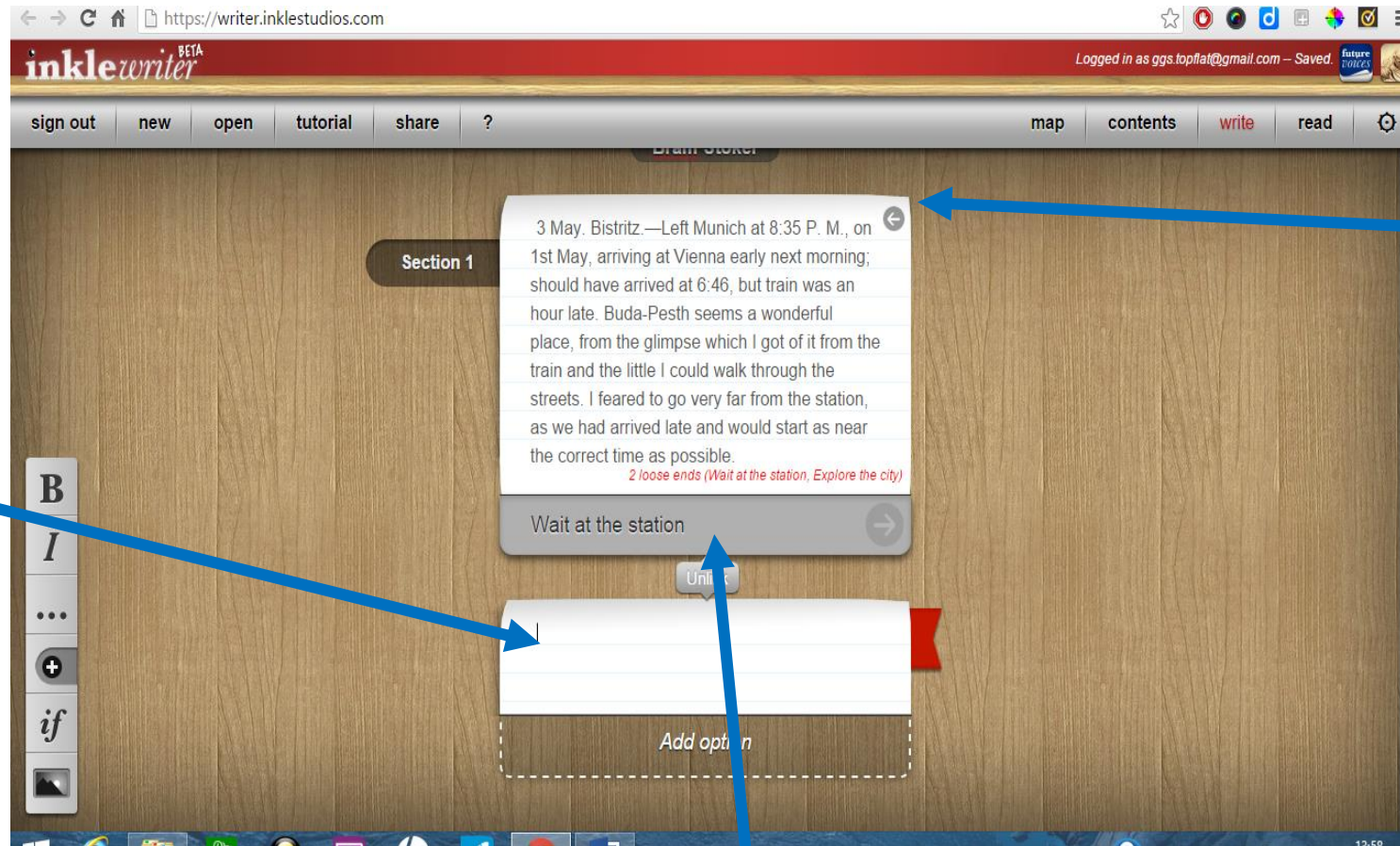
Click here and type in a new direction for your story to go in



Once you've typed a new option, click on the dotted arrow to continue the story from this point.

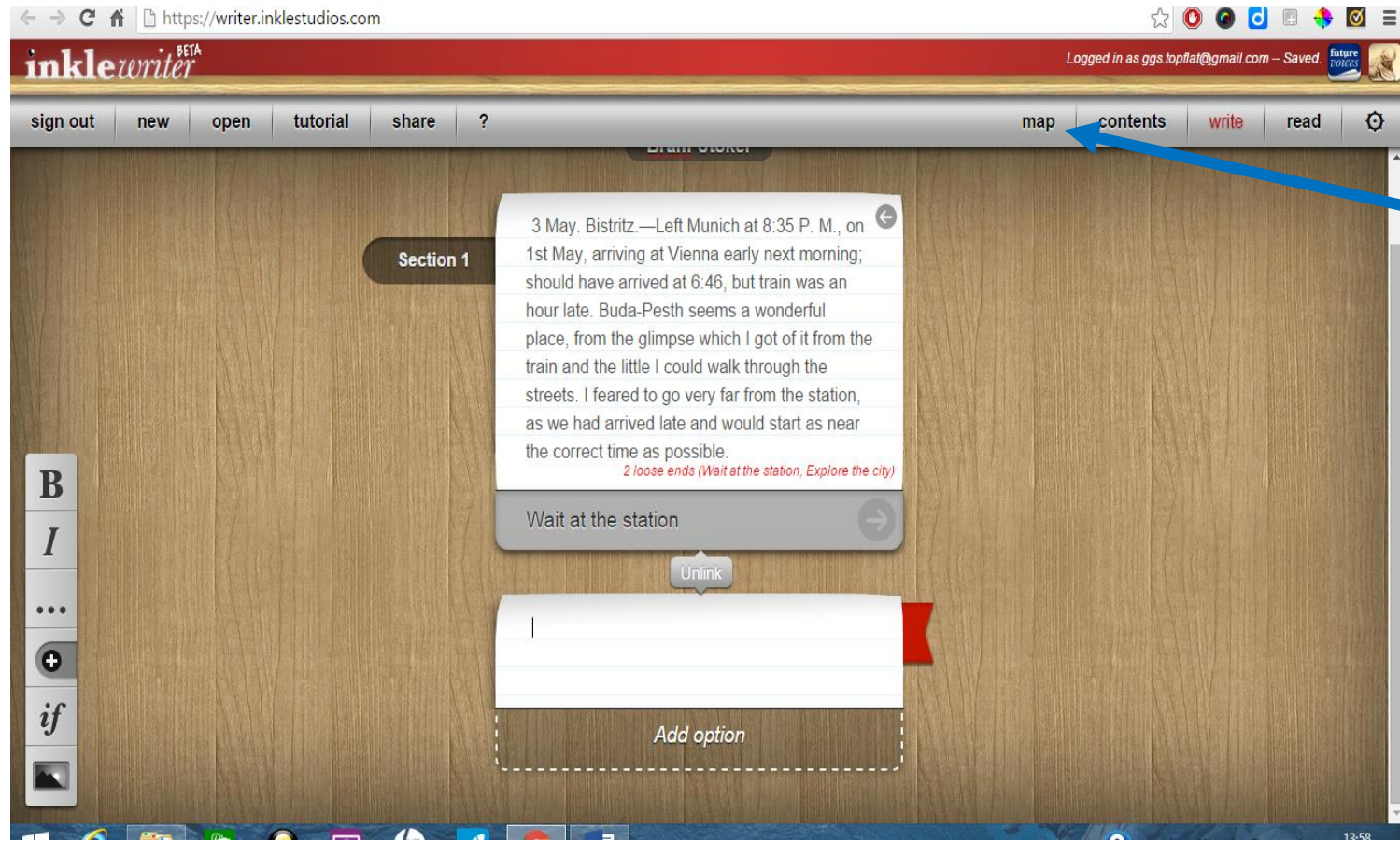
You can add another branch to the story by clicking here and typing another option.

After you've clicked on the dotted arrow, another blank box will appear. That's where you can continue your story from.



If you want to go back and edit another option, click on the small grey arrow in the top right of the white text box. Both options will appear.

You can easily work out which option or branch of the story this new box leads on from, because the option you typed in appears in dark grey and the other option text is hidden.



After you have written a few sections and added some options, click “map” to see how your story goes in different directions.

After you've clicked on map something like this will appear. See how the story divides and goes in different directions.

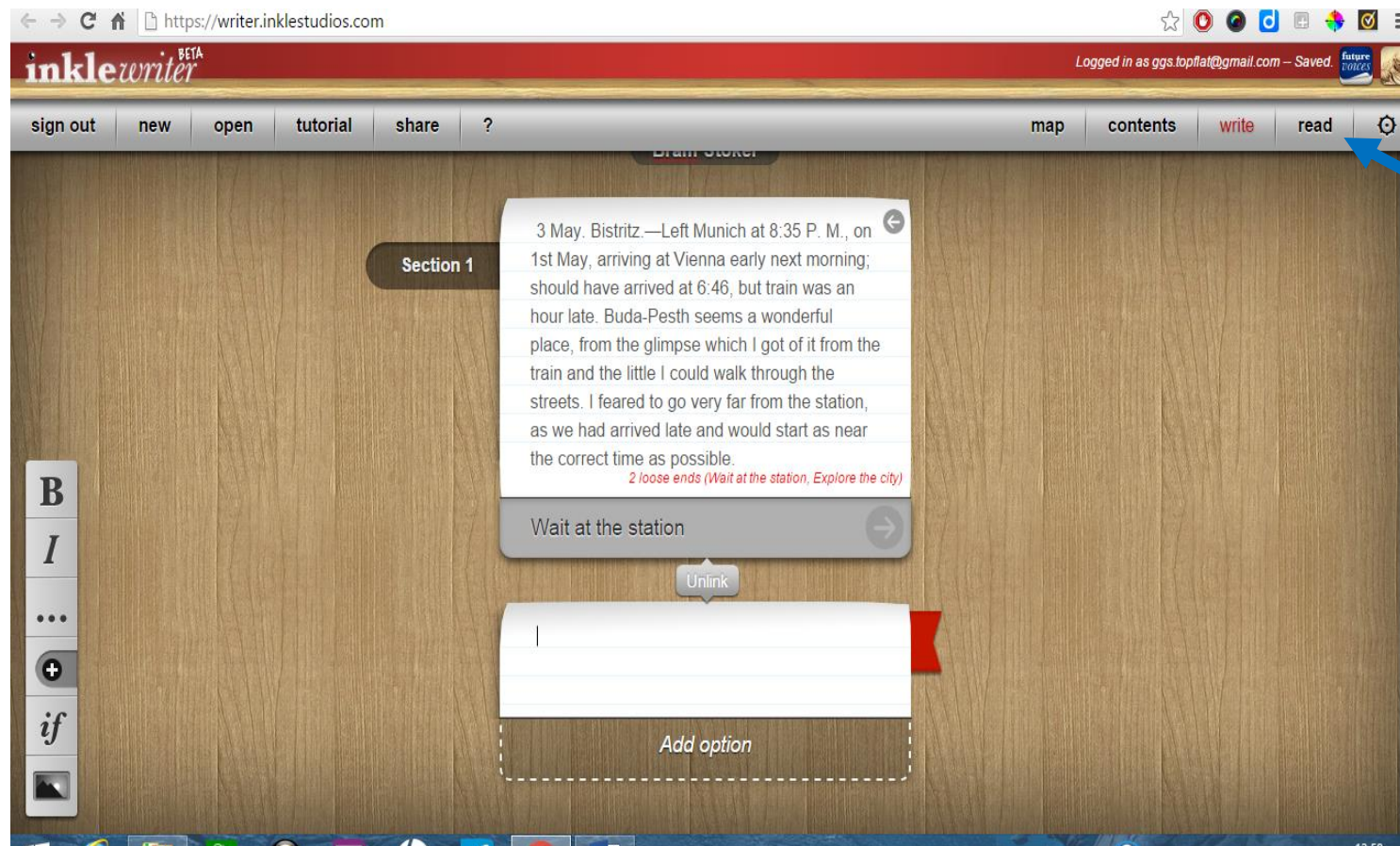
